Guidelines For SAU-PhD Fellowship Sher-e-Bangla Agricultural University, Dhaka

1. Background

Sher-e-Bangla Agricultural University (SAU) has been initiated SAU-PhD fellowship program for recognition of talent and promotion of merit in general and for encouraging talented students to undertake higher education. A certain number postgraduate fellowships in different discipline of agriculture and allied sciences would be awarded to deserving candidates. The University Grants Commission (UGC) has allocated the funds for PhD fellowship.

The purpose of the SAU-PhD fellowship is to attract outstanding agricultural graduates from home and abroad to pursue higher studies at SAU. It will also enhance the teaching and research abilities of individuals leading to enhance the institutional capacity in academic, research and other sectors. The SAU-PhD fellowship will also boost SAU's global reputation by facilitating fellows to publish research articles in high impact journals and by creating institutional links and collaboration.

2. Eligibility

Awards are open to students seeking to start PhD program at Sher-e-Bangla Agricultural University and its affiliated institutes. The fellowship competition is open to students studying in any discipline relating to agricultural science. The following categories of Bangladeshi candidates are eligible for the fellowship:

- (i) Teachers of public and private universities or colleges
- (ii) Scientists of government/autonomous research organizations or Officers of government, autonomous and reputed private organizations
- (iii) Meritorious students with requisite qualifications

Candidates shall have requisite qualifications for admission in PhD program at SAU with a minimum CGPA of 3.4 (on the scale of 4) in both the Bachelor's and Master's degree and age not more than 45 years on the final date of application.

3. Application procedure

The prospective candidates shall apply for a SAU-PhD fellowship in a prescribed application form, as shown in Appendix-1.

4. Fellow nomination procedure

- i. The Dean, Postgraduate Studies shall preliminarily scrutinize the applications. The Dean may incorporate member(s) to assist him/her in the scrutiny.

- ii. The research proposal of each preliminarily selected applicant shall be peer reviewed by experts of the respective field(s).
- iii. The candidate shall also present his/her research proposal.
- iv. Formation of the selection committee shall be as follows:
 - a. Convener: Dean, Postgraduate studies
 - b. Members: Three faculties to be nominated by the Vice-Chancellor.
 - c. Director, SAURES
- v. Total marks for evaluation shall be 100 with the following distribution:

Reviewers	: 60
Presentation	: 20
Academic results	: 15 (Bachelor: 10; Masters: 05)
Publications	: 05
- vi. In cases the marks given by two reviewers differ by more than 20%, the proposal will be reviewed by a third reviewer. The average of the two nearest marks will be considered.
- vii. The successful candidates shall be notified after completion of the selection procedure.

5. Fellowship and other allowances

(a) Fellowship allowance

Each selected PhD fellow will be entitled to a monthly fellowship allowance of BDT 30,000.00 (thirty thousand only) for a maximum duration of consecutive six semesters (36 months).

(b) Bench fee

Each selected PhD fellow will be eligible for a bench fee of BDT 60,000.00 (sixty thousand only) upon admission to the PhD program at SAU.

(c) Research grant

The research grant for each fellow will be BDT 300,000.00 (Three Lac Only). The grant will be disbursed to **the supervisor** of the selected PhD fellow in annual installments of BDT 100,000.00 (One Lac Only) over three consecutive years.

The allocated research grant shall be used to purchase chemicals, consumables, and other resources essential for conducting field and/or laboratory research.

(d) Thesis allowance

Each PhD fellow will receive thesis allowance of BDT 25,000.00 (twenty-five thousand only) after submission of the final thesis.

(e) Allowance for participation in international seminar/conference/symposium

Each PhD fellow is eligible for a one-time grant of actual cost or a maximum of BDT 1,00,000.00 (one lac only) to participate in one international seminar/workshop/conference in the second or third year of the study period. This allowance may cover airfare, registration fees and accommodation.

(f) Publication incentive:

A PhD fellow is eligible for a one-time grant of BDT 50,000.00 (fifty thousand only) upon publishing an article in a journal indexed in Scopus or other reputable database, provided the journal has a higher Impact Factor.

6. Responsibilities of PhD fellows

- (i) The fellow shall submit semester wise progress report countersigned by the respective supervisor.
- (ii) The release of funds shall depend on a satisfactory progress report. Research progress shall be evaluated on completion of each semester by the Selection Committee.
- (iii) The fellow shall acknowledge the support from SAU in any publication, whether it be a research article or a book/book chapter.

7. Termination of the scholarship

- (i) A fellow shall not accept any other award/fellowship during the tenure of the SAU-PhD fellowship; otherwise, the fellowship will be terminated.
- (ii) A fellow shall be liable to refund the total amount drawn from SAU if he/she prematurely discontinues his/her study without a valid reason acceptable to SAU or if his/her study is not deemed satisfactory by the Selection Committee.
- (iii) SAU reserves the right to terminate the fellowship for plagiarism and noncompliance/violation of the terms and conditions and research ethics deemed by the selection committee.
